Delay in water main work to extend closure of Speelyai Bay Park and boat ramp

The Cresap boat launch will be open during the closure to accommodate anglers
WOODLAND, Wash. –Due to an unavoidable delay, Speelyai Bay Park will be remain closed to the public through Friday, May 13, while the main water line into the park is being replaced to fix a leak discovered over the winter.

Cresap Bay Park will be opened during this time as an alternative for Merwin Reservoir boating access. All other amenities at Cresap Bay Park will remain closed until Memorial Day weekend when Cresap normally opens.
